



## Most Valuable Volunteer Award

This award is given annually to one person per unit in the White Horse District who, in the eyes of their peers, has made an outstanding effort toward the improvement of the unit he/she serves and the Scouting program in general. The person that the Unit Committee selects for this award should be a registered Scouter, however; nonregistered Scouters may be considered. This person will be recognized at the White Horse District Volunteer Recognition Dinner. Listed below are 8 qualities that could be considered when selecting a "Most Valuable Volunteer."

1. Has the nominee worked within the Unit for not less than two years?
2. Has the nominee given unselfishly of their time and talents?
3. Is the nominee trained?
4. Does the nominee have a heart for kids?
5. Can the nominee work well with other adults and youth?
6. Does the nominee have a helpful attitude?
7. Does he/she see a need and try to make sure it's taken care of?
8. Is the nominee willing to help others without being asked?
