As the founder of J. S. Hovnanian & Sons, one of South Jersey's largest builders of quality new homes, Mr. Hovnanian felt a desire to give back to the community. In 1998, in celebration of his 50th year as an American citizen, Mr. Hovnanian created the Hovnanian Scholarship Fund.

The purpose of this fund is to award scholarships to youth in pursuit of their American Dream. Applicants must be graduating from high school and be registered members of the Garden State Council, BSA. Interested youth are encouraged to determine their eligibility and complete the required application and essay.

The application and essay are to be submitted in writing to the Rowan Scout Training Center or by email to Patrick.Linfors@scouting.org by February 1. Recipients will be notified in advance. Checks will be mailed. Recipients will be recognized at the annual Council Volunteer Recognition Dinner.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION

- The applicant must be graduating from High School during the year of application.
- The youth must be registered in the Garden State Council as a member of Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouts, and/or Exploring. Members of Scouts BSA must be First Class rank or above. Sea Scouts, Venturers, and Explorers must be registered for at least one year.
- The youth must complete this application, listing the individual's Scouting/Exploring record, as well as religious, school, and community activities, plus need for financial assistance.
- The youth must write an essay of not less than 500 words on the subject of "What It Means to Me to be an American." The essay should be created separately from the application and be typed and double-spaced.
- All required signatures and questions must be completed. Applications must be received at the Rowan Scout Training Center or via email by February 1.
